

FACTS	WHAT DOES FINANCE OF AMERICA DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?	
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.	
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Social security number and account balances</li> <li>• Credit scores and income</li> <li>• Payment history and transaction history</li> </ul>	
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Finance of America chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Who is providing this notice?	Finance of America Mortgage LLC, Finance of America Reverse LLC, and Finance of America Home Improvement-
<b>What we do</b>	
<b>How does Finance of America protect my information?</b>	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
<b>How does Finance of America collect my personal information?</b>	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Apply for a loan or give us your income information</li> <li>• Give us your wage statements or provide account information</li> <li>• Provide employment information</li> </ul> We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates and other companies.
<b>Why can't I limit all sharing?</b>	Federal gives you the right to limit only: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sharing for affiliates everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>• Affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>• Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> </ul> State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
<b>What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?</b>	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
<b>Definitions</b>	
<b>Affiliates</b>	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial or nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Our affiliates include <i>other companies with a Finance of America name, such as Finance of America Mortgage LLC, Finance of America Reverse LLC, Finance of America Home Improvement, Boston National Title, companies with BNT in the name, The Closer, Agents National Title Insurance Company, Gulf Coast Title Insurance Company, and companies with Incenter in the name.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Nonaffiliates</b>	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Nonaffiliates we share with include <i>providers of insurance, warranty and related services and direct marketing.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Joint Marketing</b>	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Our joint marketing partners include <i>insurance providers and warranty or service contract providers.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Other Important Information</b>	
<p><b>For California Residents:</b> In accordance with California law, we will not share information we collect about California residents with nonaffiliates except as permitted by law, such as with the consent of the customer or to service the customer's accounts. We will also limit the sharing of information about you with our affiliates to the extent required by applicable California law.</p> <p><b>For Nevada Residents:</b> We are providing you this notice pursuant to Nevada law. If you prefer not to receive marketing calls from us, you may be placed on our Internal Do Not Call List by calling us at (888) 488-8471. Washington St., Suite 3900, Las Vegas, NV 89101; Phone number: 702.486.3132; email: AGINFO@ag.nv.gov.</p> <p><b>For North Dakota Residents:</b> In accordance with North Dakota law, we will not share information we collect about North Dakota residents with nonaffiliates except as permitted by law, such as with the consent of the customer or to maintain or service the customer's account.</p> <p><b>For Vermont Residents:</b> In accordance with Vermont law, we will not share information we collect about Vermont residents with nonaffiliates except as permitted by law, such as with the consent of the customer or to service the customer's accounts. We will not share creditworthiness information about Vermont residents with our affiliates except with the authorization or consent of the Vermont resident.</p>
